**PARKING INFORMATION**

- β **Free, all-day parking in Lot T on the Georgetown campus is guaranteed if you arrive no later than 8:30 a.m.** (Registration starts at 8:15 a.m.) If you arrive after 8:30/8:45, you will be competing for spaces in that lot with faculty and students coming to campus for 9 a.m. Saturday classes, although there still might be spaces for both them and us. But **carpooling is highly recommended.** (A link to a campus map showing Lot T and supplementary directions are given below.)
- β **Alternatives** if you arrive later and find that all of the parking spaces in Lot T are filled:
- parking spaces along Reservoir Road on the north side of campus;
  - scattered parking along the many residential streets near campus where you can park for at least a couple of hours before you would have to move your car (check parking zone regulations posted on poles along those streets);
  - parking in front of McDonough Gym, if you enter campus via Canal Road (this would also be free all-day parking, just as you would have in Lot T.) (See the campus map mentioned below);
  - two on-campus lots (outdoor Lot A adjacent to the hospital or indoor Lot P 1 [Podium 1] ); each charge \$2.00 an hour on Saturdays, but you would be able to move your car to Lot T once Saturday morning classes were finished. Note: Access to either of these parking lots is via Entrance One from Reservoir Road. (See the campus map mentioned below and supplementary detailed directions in the middle of the next page.)
- β If Lot T does become filled after 8:30 a.m., those spaces will all become available once again after 12 p.m. when most of the Saturday classes conclude.

- Put your cursor on any unnamed structure on the map, and the name of that structure will pop up.
- β Directions for best access to the Intercultural Center building are at the bottom of the next page.

## **ENTRANCES TO THE GEORGETOWN CAMPUS:**

1) **Two main ways:** either by means of Canal Road (on the lower south side of campus) or by Reservoir Road (on the north side of campus). Note: the old Prospect Street entrance is now a dead end.

2) **The Canal Road entrance** will have you snaking around the west side of the huge construction project. Very important: Avoid the potholes (!); otherwise, it is not a bad way to enter campus. You will be swinging around the west of the new dorm, then taking a right just before Mc Donough Gymnasium (before the tiny area with the basketball hoops), then a left just beyond the tennis courts – onto that service road between the courts and the soccer field. (It's not difficult because you're just basically following the service road around, but the road is now half dirt road/half pavement, intersected by wide construction truck entrance ways.) Follow the road up the short hill to the stop sign. By that time, you will see **Lot T** down to your right and the west entrance into that lot. Park as close to the ICC building (modern red brick building with steep angled roof segments) as you can.

3) **The Reservoir Road entrance** (on the north side of campus): Access is by Entrance #1 (between the hospital and St. Mary's Hall), and the road is one-way all around the parking lot which you will find right there. From the west perimeter of "Lot A", you will have **three choices:**

a) Head for the free parking in **Lot T**. To do this, make a left when you get to the south end of Lot A; drive to the next corner and take a right down the hill (passing under a small pedestrian bridge). (You be on the service road that runs between the Leavey Student Center on your right and Henle Village on your left, as shown on the campus map.) Continue downhill a bit further to gated Lot T.

b) Park in **Lot A** (\$2.00 an hour) until noon when faculty and students from the Saturday morning classes will start vacating spaces in Lot T. Then you can move to that free lot. Note: The entrance to Lot A is near the parking attendant's kiosk on the west side of the Lot A.

c) Park in the **Podium 1** garage under the Leavey Center (\$2.00 an hour) until noon when you can move your car to Lot T. To reach the Podium 1 garage from the roadway on the west side of Lot A, continue past the entrance to the Pasquerilla Medical Center on your right (you can see the little circular patient drop-off area on the map) and drive straight ahead and into the underground garage.

## **BEST ENTRANCES INTO THE ICC BUILDING:**

**From the back parking lots:** Enter at the southwest corner of the building (adjacent to the Jesuit cemetery.) The ICC building is basically a large rectangle inside. There are elevators in the middle of both the back (west) wall of the building (one elevator) and at the front of the building. Take an elevator to the third floor Galleria level.\*\*\*

**From the front side of the university:** From the front gates at the intersection of 37<sup>th</sup> & O Streets, NW, take the walkway diagonally to your right and head directly into the ICC building (red brick with steep roof). When you enter the front doors, you will be at the main entrance (Galleria level) to the building.\*\*\*

\*\*\* **Note:** At the time this parking information was posted (3-18-03), we did not know whether our registration would be in the Galleria of the ICC or in Copley Hall, a building directly adjacent to the ICC (we have both sites booked, but are negotiating on another issue). Please look for an eventual update from us regarding the registration site. The panels will all be held in classrooms on the first floor of the ICC.
